## ***The Post-Crescent* “Stock the Shelves” Program raises \$275,000**

The Post-Crescent’s 14<sup>th</sup> annual “Stock the Shelves” Do It! Community Campaign exceeded its \$250,000 goal by \$25,000. Nineteen food pantries in the newspaper’s circulation area benefited from this year’s program.

The success of this year’s program is attributed to *The Post-Crescent* readers and Fox Cities businesses, civic organizations and professional groups who made financial contributions.

We were able to reach our unprecedented goal because of the matching grants from our corporate partners. The J. J. Keller Foundation matched total contributions up to \$50,000, local credit unions within the Fox Cities Chapter of Credit Unions matched total contributions up to \$35,000 and Express Convenience Centers donated a nickel for every gallon of gas purchased, up to \$50,000.

Express Convenience Centers and participating credit unions also collected thousands of non-perishable food items for local pantries.
